

DataDirector Assessment Overview

Three types of Assessments:

- **Answer Sheet Assessment:**

- Used for Formative/Summative Assessments
- Create your own custom bubble sheet for students to record their answers to publisher or user created tests. Limited to 125 questions.
- Students can take assessment online.
- Link questions to standards for in-depth item analysis.
- Progress monitoring- pre/post testing
- The answer sheet you create may contain multiple question types.
- It can also be organized into sections, which you have the option to name.
- You have the option to align questions to standards, upload additional materials and create an answer key during the creation process.

- **Item Bank Assessments:**

- Create assessments using items from the Item Bank.
 - Item Banks
 - Items created by you (Note: items must be linked to standards in order to be utilized when creating an assessment.)
 - Select from District Created Items
 - Assess to Know items
- Create an assessment that can be used in accordance with answer Sheet Assessment or Online Assessment. Limited to 125 questions.
- Item questions are in multiple formats – multiple choice, constructed response, true/false, or yes/no
- Used for Formative/Summative Assessments
- Progress monitoring- pre/post testing

- **Summative Assessments:**

- A spreadsheet to store, display, and report summative data for test scores, proficiency levels, and results from state, local. and custom created tests.
 - Frequently used with:
 - DIBELS
 - STAR
 - MEAP
 - ACT, including EXPLORE and PLAN
